

Custom Jewelry boxes: checklist and practical selection criteria

Here is a quick and useful process for comparing materials, formats, internal organisation and customisation before placing your order.

1. Start from actual use

Before comparing models, decide whether the jewelry box will mainly be used to store, organise or display small items. Jewelry and watches require enough space and an internal arrangement that matches the size and shape of the objects.

If the aim is display in a case or shop window, also consider the presence of a mirror; if internal order matters more, focus on compartments, pockets, cushions and lined sections.

2. Material: what changes in the choice

Material	Characteristics	When to consider it
Bamboo	Natural appearance and grain that make every piece different; works very well with engraving.	Consider when the natural finish and recognisable character of the material are important.
Cotton	Soft and suitable for holding delicate items.	Useful when a textile, soft or foldable solution is preferred.
Faux leather	Smooth surface, easy to clean and elegant in appearance.	Consider when finish and ease of cleaning are important.

3. Check the format before ordering

The measurements shown help you understand differences in size and capacity. Before choosing, always compare them with the items that will be stored.

Format	Indicative size	Practical note
Compact round	8 x 2.5 x 7.6 cm	Generally rigid and compact in size.
Slim rectangular	30 x 18 cm	Can be soft and foldable.
Compact rectangular	8.5 x 4 x 4 cm	Small footprint and more structured shape.
Rectangular (larger)	15 x 10 x 5 cm	More available space than compact models.

4. Compartments and accessories: the most important difference

The internal configuration directly affects how items are positioned and removed. A single compartment leaves more free space, while an organised structure keeps the different elements more stable.

Element	What to check
Single compartment	Uniform and generally flat space; items remain loose and easy to remove; greater capacity when there are no dividers.
Straps and pockets	Help separate and secure small items; some pockets may have a zip.
Cushions and lined sections	Help keep items more stable; linings may be velvet or soft fabric.
Mirror	May be integrated under the lid and is also useful when the jewelry box is used for display.
Closure and opening	The closure may be magnetic; some models add a faux-leather tab to make opening easier.

5. Match the customisation technique to the material

Technique	Practical indication
Screen printing	Economical and resistant solution, with a pleasant raised effect to the touch.
Pad printing	Economical, suitable when the print area is small and fast production is needed.
Engraving	Elegant choice, suitable for adding depth and reproducing text or images with good definition.
Epoxy resin sticker	Durable and suitable for four-colour printing.
Transfer printing	Mainly applicable to fabrics.
Digital transfer	Suitable for flat surfaces and with no limitations on the use of colours.

6. Use context: what to focus on

Context	Useful checks
Jewelry stores, goldsmiths and boutiques	Internal organisation, aesthetic finish and consistency of the customisation with the products.
Suites, hotel rooms, showrooms and display spaces	Format, finish and presence of a mirror when the jewelry box is also used as a display element.
Ceremonies, receptions and gifts	Dimensions, material, logo position and the possibility of evaluating a sample before ordering.

7. How to read the product page

Before confirming a model, use the product page to check three elements: measurements and internal arrangement, positions and dimensions of the print area, and availability of customisation techniques. When available, the “BUY SAMPLE” function also lets you physically evaluate the product before deciding.

Final checklist

- ☐ I checked the measurements and internal arrangement on the selected product page.
- ☐ I decided whether I need more free space or greater organisation of the items.
- ☐ I checked for a mirror, magnetic closure or opening tab, if relevant to the intended use.
- ☐ I checked the available print position, dimensions and technique for the model.
- ☐ If available and useful for the decision, I considered purchasing a sample.
